

#### WHY STUDY IN CANADA?

Ranked amongst the top 10 countries since 2004 in the Quality of Life Index by the United Nations, Canada is known for its excellent education institutions, multiplicity of top quality education programs in various streams and an innovative economy that welcomes international students with open arms. It has also been ranked #1 by the Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD) for its achievements in higher education.



#### **QUALITY EDUCATION**

Canada's education is known for quality and excellence across the entire global education sector. Great importance is given to learning and maintaining high standards of imparting education here. The country spends more on education as compared to the OECD average, and is the second highest among the G-8 countries. Canada fosters diversified study options at different levels. Moreover, a number of Canadian institutions are involved in international research partnerships to study and address major world issues.



#### **COST OF STUDY**

Canadian institutions offer lower tuition rates than many other countries, which mean international students can save considerably by studying in Canada. All Canadian institutions receive public funding through their provincial governments, which allows for lower tuition fees and ensures all institutions adhere to a code of academic standards.



#### **EDUCATION SYSTEM**

**College:** In Canada, the term college usually refers to a community college or a technical, applied arts, or applied science school. These are post-secondary institutions granting certificates, diplomas, associate's degree, and bachelor degree, Post graduate degree.

**University:** A university is an institution of higher education and research, which grants academic degrees in a variety of subjects. A university is a corporation that provides both undergraduate education and postgraduate education.

**Graduate school:** A graduate school is a school that awards advanced academic degrees (i.e. master's degree, Ph.D.)

#### **ENGLISH LANGUAGE REQUIREMENT**

Before getting admission into Canadian University or College, student has to prove their proficiency in the English Language by submitting IELTS or TOEFL(ibt) Score. An IELTS band of 6.0/6.5 for Undergraduate and 6.5/7.0 for Postgraduate courses or a TOEFL score of 80 and above for Undergraduate and 90 and above for Postgraduate courses is desirable.



#### INTAKE

There are three intakes available to study in Canadian colleges and universities. International students should planned their study in Canada one year in advance. The major intakes are fall (September) for which deadline is 1<sup>st</sup> February and winter (January) having deadline of 1<sup>st</sup> August. Many colleges and Universities do offer summer (May) intake having deadline of 1<sup>st</sup> November.



#### **TUITION FEES**

Tuition fees for Canadian institutions vary from course to course and institution to institution. On an average, a student needs to pay a minimum of C\$12,000 to C\$18,000 approximately per year.



#### LIVING EXPENSES

Living expenses in Canada for International Students are about C\$10,500. Rent costs will vary greatly depending on where you study, and if you live on or off campus.

If you choose to live off campus you will likely pay around \$600 a month to rent a room and at least \$1,800 a month to rent an apartment.



#### **WORK DURING STUDIES**

International students are allowed to work up to 20 hours per week off-campus during education and 40 hours per week in their vacation. Students can earn approximately C\$10.25/hr onwards. Students can work full-time off campus during co-op terms, earning C\$400 - C\$1,000 per month.



#### WORK PERMIT AND IMMIGRATION

International graduates from Canadian higher education institutions also have the opportunity to work in Canada for up to three years following the completion of their program.

To work in Canada after you graduate, you must apply for a work permit under the Post-Graduation Work Permit Program (PGWPP). If you would like to look into staying in Canada as a permanent resident after you finish your studies, there are several programs available, each with its own requirements.





### FAQ'S

- What are the alternatives to post-secondary education in Canada?
- → In Canada, tertiary education includes every type of formal teaching program past secondary schools, be it academic, vocational, technical, or the professional education offered primarily by universities, colleges, and special institutes.
- What type of a high school diploma is accepted if applying in a Canadian post-secondary educational institution?
- → If you are concerned if the high school diploma you've earned in your home-country will be considered legit in Canada, worry no more since any student possessing a government-accredited high school diploma from their home country may apply for admission to a Canadian University.
- What are the common requirements into getting accepted in a Canadian University/College?
- → In order to get admitted in a Canadian tertiary education institution there are requirements students will have to meet, whether it I an undergraduate or a postgraduate program. Depending on the field of studies, programs and other relevant factors competition can vary. The two essential criteria are however, high school grades/performance as well as language skills be it English (in most of the provinces).
- What type of language skill does one need in order to get accepted in a Canadian post-secondary institution?
- → TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language) scores are the most common language requirement for American universities. IELTS (International English Language Testing System) exam scores are the most common language requirement for Canadian universities. But most universities will accept either test as proof of your English language ability. You can take TOEFL and IELTS exams at testing centres worldwide.
- Is there any additional requirement for international students willing to apply in a Canadian post-secondary institution?
- → International students are required to submit an essay and a personal statement of what they think they are fit for enrolling in the designated program together with documents stating their work experience (if any) up to the date. Of course documents like reference letters, extracurricular activity certificates and other proof of skills is always a bonus and very much appreciated.
- What type of documentation will I need in order to apply for a student visa in Canada?
- Applicants are generally required Proof of acceptance and enrolment to an accredited academic institution in Canada; Possess a valid passport/travel document, and provide proof of financial support; Ties to their home country and evidence of their intention to leave Canada at the end of their studies. Additionally, students have to have proof of no criminal history or endangering medical conditions of any sort and willingly undergo medical testing as required.
- How long will I have to wait to be issued a Canadian student visa/ study permit?
- → Processing times vary. It depends on the type of application you submit, and where it is processed.
- Can I work while studying in Canada?
- → Working in Canada as a student is only possible if you apply for a work permit; otherwise international students can take up solely on-campus jobs.
- What are the requirements in order to obtain a work permit, while studying in Canada?
- → To qualify for the work permit, you must have a valid study permit and be a full-time student at a recognized postsecondary educational institution. Recognized institutions generally include a public, post-secondary college or university and degree-granting programs offered by private institutions throughout Canada.
- Is my spouse/dependant allowed to work in Canada?
- → If your spouse or any dependant wants to work while in Canada, they must apply for their own work permit. Your spouse permit will be valid for the same period that you are authorized to study in Canada.
- Do I need Health insurance if I want to study in Canada?
- As for international students in Canada, they must all have health insurance one way or the other.


